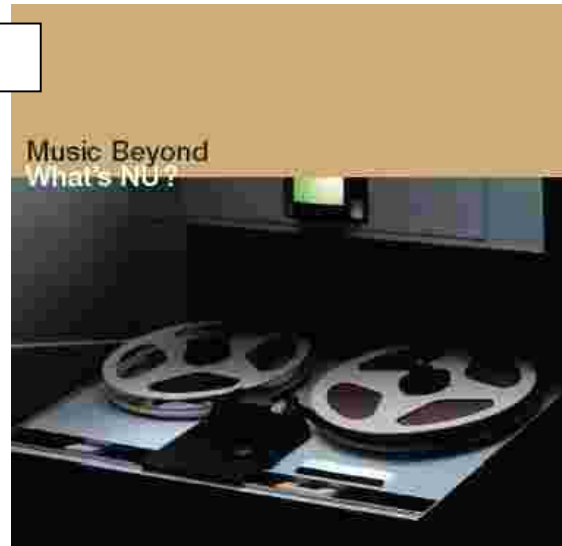

Why NU JAZZ?

Nobody grows up by listening to jazz music only. This is also true for jazz musicians. All of these diverse musical forms are now compatible. Jazz is no longer based on harmonic, structural and improvisational principles.
